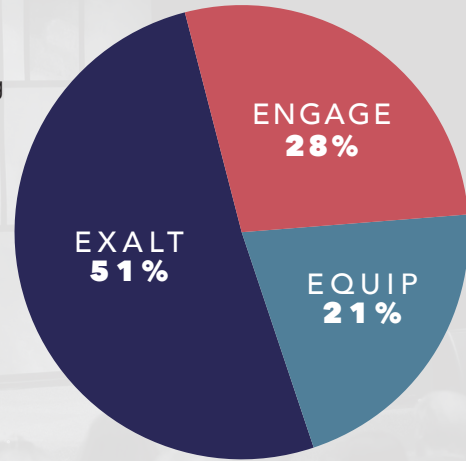


EXALT

CALVARYPHX Early Learning Center

The ELC now has 9 full-time classrooms, serving nearly 90 children ages 6 weeks to 5 years. In 2025, the ELC celebrated its third year as one of the top early childhood programs in the north valley and expanded partnerships with programs that serve families across the state. They partner with multiple community agencies including Quality First, CACFP, DES, Southwest Human Development, Christian Family Care, Washington School District, First Things First, and
