This position requires flexibility, teamwork, and a positive attitude while helping maintain classroom routines and licensing standards throughout the center.

Primary Responsibilities:

- I. Spiritual Responsibilities:
 - Be a committed follower of Jesus Christ and seek to be a role model in attitude, speech, and actions in a consistent daily walk.
 - Demonstrate by example the importance of Scripture knowledge, Bible Study, prayer, sharing of faith, and Christian fellowship.
- II. Floater Teacher Responsibilities:
 - Assist in classrooms as assigned for infants through preschool-aged children.
 - Support teachers with daily classroom activities, transitions, meals, and supervision.
 - Maintain a safe, clean, and organized learning environment.
 - Help implement age-appropriate activities and curriculum.
 - Provide positive guidance and redirection to children.
 - Build caring relationships with children, families, and staff.
 - Follow all center policies, health and safety procedures, and Arizona licensing requirements.
 - Assist during staff breaks, absences, and high-need times throughout the center.
 - Support nap time, diapering/toileting, and classroom sanitation procedures.
 - Participate in staff meetings and trainings as required.

Qualifications Include:

- High school diploma or equivalent required.
- Previous childcare experience required.
- Ability to work with children of all ages.
- Must possess a valid fingerprint clearance card and meet Arizona DHS licensing requirements.
- CPR/First Aid certification preferred or willingness to obtain.
- Strong communication, teamwork, and organizational skills.
- Ability to lift up to 30 pounds and actively engage with children throughout the day.

- Positive and servant-hearted attitude.
- Passion for early childhood education.
- Ability to adapt quickly to different classroom needs.
- Professional and compassionate demeanor.
